

**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE GARAGE SALE ORDINANCE TO ALLOW SALES ON SUNDAY.**

**FINDINGS:** The current ordinance of the City of Liberty, South Carolina (the "City") prohibits garage sales on Sunday. Council understands that different religious faiths observe different days of worship and the prohibition of sales on Sunday is unnecessary. Therefore, Chapter 11, Article V, Section 11-168 should be amended to allow garage sales on Sunday.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Liberty, South Carolina, in a meeting duly assembled, that Section 11-168 of The Code of Ordinances of the City of Liberty, South Carolina, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 11-168. - Hours of operation.**

Garage sales shall be limited in time to no more than the daylight hours of two consecutive days, excluding Sundays.
