**AN ORDINANCE**

**TO AMEND CHAPTER 23, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 23-92 “SPECIFIC STANDARDS”  
OF THE LIBERTY CITY CODE**

**Whereas**, the City of Liberty works to maintain the general welfare of the City; and

**Whereas**, establishing standards to protect the community from unsightly materials or conditions is a means of maintaining the general welfare of the City; and

**Whereas**, controlling graffiti is a means to protect the community from unsightly materials or conditions.

**Now Therefore**, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Liberty, South Carolina that:

**Section 1: Amendment to Section 23-92 of Chapter 23, Article IV of the Liberty Code of Ordinances**

The language included in Section 23-92 of Chapter 23, Article IV of the Liberty Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 23-92 – Specific Standards**

Add subsection (5):

(5) Graffiti located on railroad property, dumpsters, vacant buildings, news racks, and other areas open to the public.

**Section 2.**

This Ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage, designated as Ordinance No. 2019-10.
