AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND CHAPTER 23, ARTICLE II, SECTION 23-31 "REGULATION OF NOXIOUS WEEDS AND VEGETATION" OF THE LIBERTY CITY CODE

Whereas, the City of Liberty works to maintain the health, safety and general welfare of the City; and

Whereas, establishing community standards is a means of maintaining the health, safety and general welfare of the City; and

Whereas, establishing standards that controls the height of weeds and vegetation is a means to help ensure the health, safety and general welfare of the community.

Now Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Liberty, South Carolina that:

Section 1: Amendment to Section 23-31 of Chapter 23, Article II of the Liberty Code of Ordinances

The language included in Section 23-31 of Chapter 23, Article II of the Liberty Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 23-31 - Regulation of Noxious Weeds and Vegetation

Replace subsection (a) with the following:

(a) No person owning or occupying any property within the city shall permit any grass, weeds or any vegetation over 12 8 inches in height, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon the premises so as to emit any unpleasant or noxious odor or to conceal any filthy deposit or to create or produce pollen. Any grass, weeds or other vegetation growing upon any premises in the city in violation of any of the provisions of this article is hereby declared to be a nuisance and detrimental to the health, safety, cleanliness and comfort of the inhabitants of the city.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage, designated as Ordinance No. 2020-03.
