## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 20-3

## OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY, SOUTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, by Ordinance the method of election of members of the City Council calls for the mayor to be elected at-large and for the six Council members to be elected one from each of the four wards and two at-large; and

WHERAS, an independent study of the 2020 Census data by Revenue and Fiscal Affair, South Carolina, has developed benchmark statistics, copy attached, which indicate that there is a need to revise the boundaries of the four single-member districts; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposed redistricting plan on April 10th, 2023; and

WHEREAS, is the desire of the Mayor and the City Council to accept the recommendations from Revenue and Fiscal Affairs and pursuant to Section 5-15-20 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, to adopt the four single-member districts as depicted on "Plan I-2023";

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the governing body of the City of Liberty, South Carolina, in Council fully assembled this 10th day of April 2023 that Section 20-3 of Chapter 20-Elections, Article 1.- In General of the Code of Laws of the City of Liberty, South Carolina, Is hereby amended to read as the following:

Chapter 20- ELECTIONS
