Their dedication is greatly appreciated. The good news is, the new pipe was delivered yesterday, and GWS is on top of the situation.

Additionally, I want you to know that the City of Liberty has always had a contingency plan in place for situations like these. As a result, we are currently receiving water from Easley Central Water District, which ensures a steady water supply with no expected issues in the foreseeable future.

I want to emphasize that there is no need to worry or conserve water at this time. The city has taken steps to ensure that you will not experience any water shortage during this repair process.

Our staff will continue to monitor the situation closely and keep you updated if anything changes. Your safety and well-being are our top priorities, and we are committed to providing you with a reliable water supply.
